PPE, technical and matchday operations

- The Parents car or external space at the side of the portacabin has been identified as the Covid-19 isolation room.
- All activities including warm ups should be conducted with social distancing.
- Balls to be retrieved by staff who have complied with the appropriate ball retrieval regulations.
- Staff will be responsible for disinfecting corner flags and goal posts.
- Academy staff will be responsible for disinfecting balls.
- Drinks breaks should be short and socially distanced.
- Players should not share drinks.
- No manual therapy treatment of players by staff will be conducted.

Cleaning and disinfection

- Prior to any of the trials commencing a deep clean will take place in accordance with club protocols and government guidance.
- High touch areas (toilets, doors, wash basins) will be cleaned regularly.
- Cleaning staff will wear aprons and gloves whilst cleaning.
- Should a confirmed case of Covid-19 have been on the premises cleaning will take place in line with the government guidelines for cleaning in a non-healthcare setting.

Staff to be reminded that wearing of gloves is not a substitute for good hand washing.
